Course Description

From large corporations to governments, from international organizations to renowned academic institutions – everyone wants to know what the future of work will bring. And not few claim that they already do.

But which forecasts and predictions really hold? How can we distinguish substance from noise? Which topics really matter? Who is in charge? And what actions can or should we take in our own lives to create the version of the future that we actually want?

This course offers a three-week virtual journey for students from around the world that allows them to explore the future of work from a range of different angles and perspectives, while reflecting on their own role as current and future leaders. With a mix of instruction and hands-on exercises, students will discover ways to better understand, prepare for, and ultimately shape the future of work.
